## Arrangements of P.1- P.6 Regular Assessments for Learning and P. 2 – P. 6 Summative Assessments (Examinations)

## (1) Aims of Conducting Regular Assessments for Learning at Primary 1 to 6

- To enable students to identify their own strengths and weaknesses in learning.
- To enable teachers to diagnose students' learning situations, revise instructional progress, formulate appropriate teaching strategies, thereby promoting the effectiveness of teaching and learning.
- Parents can cooperate with the school in improving children's learning.

# Types of Assessments

(a) **Formative Assessments** 

- Time: During lessons (please pay attention to subject teachers' announcements)
- Subjects: Chinese, English, Mathematics, General Studies (GS), Music, Visual Arts (VA), Physical Education (PE), Putonghua (PTH) & Computer Studies
- Method: Questions, observations, skill assessments, oral assessments, written assessments

## (b) Primary 2 to 6 Progressive Assessment

• Progressive assessment serves as a preparation for the summative assessment (examination) in each term, and it includes Chinese, English, Mathematics and General Studies as the assessment subjects. Parents have to pay attention to subject teachers' announcements and remind students to revise and consolidate the acquired knowledge. For students who are absent in progressive assessments due to illnesses or personal issues, no make-up assessments will be arranged. However, to serve for future revision purpose, students have to complete the corresponding assessments at home and return them to school for teachers' marking.

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## (2) Summative Assessments for Primary 2 to 6 (Examinations)

• There are THREE summative assessments (examination) in total throughout this academic year. The period and weighting of the assessments are listed below:

(4) Arrangements on Absence in Examinations

Parents of P. 2 – P. 6 students must CALL the school on the day of examination, FILL in the STUDENT HANDBOOK to inform the school regarding the leave of absence, and SUMBIT a medical certificate as a proof of sick leave after returning to school. Make-up examination will <u>ONLY</u> be arranged for those applications that are accepted by school, within two days after the original examination). For students being absent for three days or more, NO make-up examinations will be arranged.

• The 3rd examinations in P. 5, and the 1st and 2nd examinations in P. 6 are internal examinations for Secondary School Places Allocation (SSPA) purpose. Students' examination results will be submitted to EDB for calculation of allocation bands after mark adjustments and standardization. The SSPA-related subjects are Chinese, English, Mathematics, General Studies, Music and Visual Arts. For students who are absent in such examinations due to illnesses, make-up examinations will not be arranged unless a medical certificate is presented. For students who are unable to complete SSPA-related examinations due to special reasons, the school will report the situation to relevant departments of EDB and handle the situation according to the departments' instructions.

#### (5) Criteria for Class Allocation Mechanism P. 1 promoting to P. 2:

- All classes compile of students with mixed levels of learning ability.
- Those Non-Chinese Speaking (NCS) students who need more assistance in Chinese will be allocated to the same class as far as possible, so that appropriate support can be provided to them by the school.
- With no examinations, students' "Learning Report" instead of "Report Card" will be received by parents.

### P. 2 promoting to P. 3 or above:

• Students are allocated to different classes according to learning ability. Students demonstrating the best learning ability will be allotted to Class A, and the next students to Class B, while Classes C and D compile of students with mixed levels of learning ability.
