Dear Parents,

A Suspected Outbreak of Upper Respiratory Tract Infection in Class 1B

Yesterday afternoon, our school received a notification from the Centre for Health Protection regarding a suspected outbreak of upper respiratory tract infection in Class 1B. The Centre for Health Protection will conduct medical surveillance on Class 1B until 9/11/2023 (may be extended due to new cases). The school has strengthened the cleaning and disinfection of the campus, and will also remind Class 1B students and staff to wear masks, wash hands frequently, and pay attention to personal hygiene during school to reduce the risk of infection. If a student has a fever, (s)he must wait two days after the fever subsides before (s)he can return to school. Parents are now requested to pay close attention to the health condition of your children. If (s)he feels unwell, please call the school as soon as possible. The school will maintain close contact with the Centre for Health Protection and closely monitor the health situation of teachers and students on campus.

The school will continue to further strengthen the cleaning and disinfection work in the school in accordance with the instructions of the Centre for Health Protection, and at the same time closely monitor the health conditions of teachers and students in the school. If parents want to know more about the school, they can contact the class teachers or Ms. CHEUNG Po Ching, the senior teacher.
